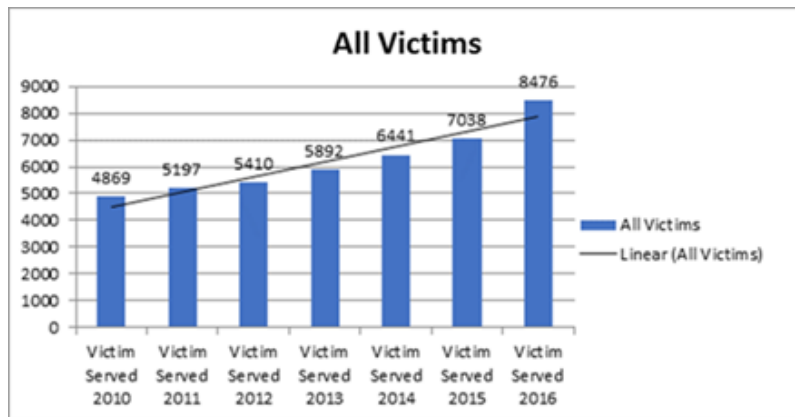

## Victims Served

Since the SFDA's Victim Services Division began implementing its innovative and strategic services, the number of victims of crime served by the office has increased a dramatic 74% since 2010. As indicated below, the same number has increased every year, with, most recently, a 20% jump from 2015 to 2016.



## Compensation for Victims of Crime

The Victim Services Division assisted more than 2,000 victims of crime access \$1.6 million in State Victims Crime Compensation for lost wages, medical, mental health, and funeral expenses.

## Time Spent with Victims

Volunteers and interns provided 2,168 hours of service to victims of crime.

Pink and Red, our new victim services' dogs, offered non-judgmental comfort and support to children and vulnerable victims.

Thousands of community members were reached through outreach and training.
