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NARRATIVE

On April 27, 2023, Officer Juarez # 4140 and I were in full Police uniform and driving a marked Police vehicle. At approximately 1836 hours we responded to 901 Market St, (V2) Walgreens, regarding a report of a security guard shooting a shoplifter.

Upon arrival I saw (V1) Chyna Lasheabrown outside of the entrance of Walgreens unconscious but breathing. Lasheabrown's top was off, and I could visibly see Lasheabrown had a an approximate ½ inch wound to her right breast, which was consistent with a gunshot wound. Officer Forbes #2122 and I rolled Lasheabrown on her side and checked for an exit wound, with negative results. While assessing Lasheabrown for additional wounds SFFD medical personnel arrived on scene and took over medical care.

Officer Juarez # 4140 detained (B1) Michael Anthony, who is contracted to do security for Walgreens. Anthony is employed with Kingdom Group Protection Services. Officer Juarez seized and secured all of Anthony's weapons and other security equipment. Officer Juarez maintained custody of the equipment until CSI later arrived on scene and seized the weapons and equipment. Refer to Officer Juarez' statement for further detail.

Officer Juarez transferred control of Anthony to Sgt. Connell #433 who separated him from all other parties until NIU arrived and continued with the investigation.

Officer Lee #1179 rode code 3 with AMR 108 to SFGH with Lasheabrown.

Sgt. Connell sat with the Anthony while waiting for investigators to come with a (EVD) gunshot residue kit. Sgt. Connell waited with Anthony for approximately one hour and Anthony talked for most of the time, while Sgt. Connell's BWC was activated per department policy. Sgt. Connell did not ask Anthony any questions regarding the incident. Anthony described what led up to the shooting and discussed what he was thinking throughout the shooting. Anthony also described a prior detention/ arrest in which his firearms were confiscated. Anthony also talked about his ongoing attempt to obtain a CCW, which he does not have yet. Anthony stated he thought he was potentially in a life-and-death situation because Lasheabrown had been aggressive, and Anthony did not know what Lasheabrown was going to do next. Refer to Sgt. Connell's statement for further details.

Officer Juarez and Lt. Obot #2259 contacted DOC and notified Officer DeFilippo #2107 of the incident. Officer DeFilippo advised Lt Obot that NIU and CSI would be responding to the scene.

Officer Rallis #238 and Officer Simpson #2137 from CSI arrived on scene, took photographs of the scene, and seized two firearms, a fired cartridge, and seized all of Anthony's property from Officer Juarez.

NIU Sqt. Habib #2329 and Sqt. Cuadro #1253 arrived on scene and took over the investigation.

Sgt. Cuadro instructed Officer Juarez to seize and search Lasheabrown's (PFSK)bag. In the bag was the following: (SRR1) five candy products and 1 empty sprite bottle and (PFSK) miscellaneous clothing. Officer Juarez returned the 5 candy products to Walgreens and the cashier provided us with a (EVD) training receipt.

Officer Jimenez #2580 started a (EVD) crime scene log and maintained the crime scene log until the crime scene was broken down. Officer Jimenez later gave Officer Juarez control of the crime scene log which he booked into Tenderloin Station. Officer Jimenez was instructed by NIU to seize (EVD) two chest seals from the crime scene which she later gave to Officer Juarez, and he booked at Tenderloin Station.

While returning to Tenderloin Station, Officer Jensen #1423, advised us that Lesheabrown was pronounced deceased by SFGH Physician R. Tesoriero at 2050 hours. Officer Juarez notified Officer DeFilippo from DOC; Officer DeFilippo notified Homicide who later responded to the scene. Officer Jensen and Officer Lee escorted Lesheabrown with SFGH staff until secured in the SFGH morgue. Officer Cato #250 responded to SFGH and remained with Lesheabrown until the SF Medical Examiner Hoogasian #121 seized Lashaebrown's body and

provided Officer Cato with a (EVD) ME property receipt. Officer Cato later provided the property receipt to Officer Juarez which he later booked at Tenderloin Station.

Officer Barajas #2134 arrived on scene and retrieved video footage of the incident. Officer Barajas spoke with (R1) who is a manager for Walgreens. was the video custodian who gave Officer Barajas permission to obtain video footage of the incident. Officer Barajas observed the video footage of the incident which showed the following: Lasheabrown walked into the Walgreens department store wearing a white T-Shirt, grey sweatpants, white shoes, and carrying a light-colored bag. Lasheabrown walked towards two different shelves collecting items and continued to walk towards the rear of the store. While walking down an aisle Lasheabrown grabbed a bag from a shelf, placing it into her bag that was with her when she walked into the store. Anthony was standing near the front entrance of the store and appeared to act as a security guard wearing all black clothing and tactical gear.

As Lasheabrown was approaching the exit she was confronted by Anthony. Anthony appeared to reach out his hand as if to ask for something. Lasheabrown continued to walk forward and bump into Anthony. Anthony pushed Lasheabrown, and then began punching Lasheabrown. Lasheabrown fell to the ground and Anthony stood over her. Lasheabrown got up and Anthony placed his arm around her neck in a choke hold position and lifted her into the air. While Lasheabrown was in the air Anthony began to swing her body side to side.

Both Subjects fell to the floor and Anthony was still on top of Lasheabrown with his arm around her neck in a choke hold position. Anthony finally let go of Lasheabrown and allowed her to stand up. Lasheabrown grabbed her belongings and walked towards the exit. As Lasheabrown approached the exit, she turned back towards Anthony. While Anthony and Lasheabrown were facing each other, Anthony is seen holding a firearm in his right hand. As Lasheabrown was walking backwards out of the store, Lasheabrown appeared to gesture towards Anthony as if to lunge at him. Anthony then raised his firearm towards Lasheabrown while she was outside of the store and Lasheabrown fell backwards and appeared to be motionless on the ground. Refer to Officer Barajas' statement for further details.

Officer Barajas loaded the video footage onto a (EVD) USB memory stick. Officer Barajas later gave me control of the USB and I gave control to Officer Juarez which he later booked at Tenderloin Station.


I spoke with a (RW3) unknown subject who provided me with a statement but refused to give me any contact or identifying information and refused to stay on scene for investigators. RW3 stated the following: She was in Walgreens and waiting in line to pay for her items. RW3 saw Anthony and Lasheabrown in a physical altercation by the front exit doors of the store. RW3 stated that at some point Anthony was on top of Lasheabrown and she could hear Lasheabrown saying "get off of me," and "let me go." RW3 stated that at some point Lasheabrown walked out of the store, she heard someone say, "he spit on him." RW3 then heard what she believed to be a gunshot and saw Lasheabrown on the ground.

I then spoke with (RW5) who is a Walgreens supervisor and stated the following: was behind the registers at Walgreens and saw Anthony who is Walgreens security in a physical fight with Lasheabrown. stated that she saw Anthony put his arm around Lasheabrowns neck. could not hear what Anthony and Lasheabrown were saying. Anthony and Lasheabrown stopped physically fighting. Lasheabrown walked out of Walgreen and spit on Anthony while he was still inside of Walgreens. Anthony then shot Lasheabrown once. did not see when Anthony pulled his gun out. stated that during the physical altercation she saw store merchandise falling. could not clarify what the store merchandise was and if it was falling from Lasheabrown's person. was one of the 911 callers.
I then spoke with (RW4) who is an employee for Walgreens and stated the following: heard what he believed to be a gunshot. It hen saw Lasheabrown on the ground outside of Walgreens. Upon reviewing video footage was nowhere near the incident during the altercation or the shooting.
Officer McNamara #1633 spoke with (RW1) who stated the following: was inside of Walgreen shopping. Was was waiting in line when he saw Anthony blocking Lasheabrown from exiting the store. Saw Lasheabrown lunge towards Anthony as if she were going to strike Anthony. Lasheabrown then spit in Anthony's face and Anthony pulled his pistol and fired one round at Lasheabrown. Attempted to render aid prior to Police arriving. Refer to Officer McNamara's statement for further detail.

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Officer Katsumoto #2429 spoke with (RW2) Donald Washington who recorded (EVD) two videos with his cellphone. The videos showed Lasheabrown on ground and an unknown male checking her pulse. The Unknown male and Anthony began to remove Lasheabrown's clothes off. Anthony pulls out what appears to be gauze and attempts to provide medical aid to Lasheabrown. Officer Katsumoto burned the two videos onto a (EVD) CD which Officer Juarez took control of.

Officer Katsumoto performed a GSR kit on Anthony on scene. Officer Katsumoto later booked the GSR kit at Tenderloin Station.

Officer Katsumoto and Officer Suzuki # 1669 transported Anthony to The Homicide Office located at 850 Bryant Street. Homicide conducted their investigation.

With the approval from Sgt. McWilliams #1227 Officer Katsumoto and Officer Suzuki walked Anthony to County Jail #1 where he was booked for homicide.

Officer Juarez booked all Evidence at Tenderloin Station.

During this investigation, I activated my (BWC1) Body Worn Camera to capture video and audio recordings of the event which was later uploaded by me to Evidence.com. All written accounts in the above statement are a summary of what was said to me. For an exact account of statements made by all on scene witnesses, victims, suspects, officers or detainees, review my captured footage which was later uploaded to evidence.com.

On the above date and time I was in full police uniform and driving a marked police vehicle when I responded to the Walgreens at 825 Market St in regard to a shooting. During the investigation, I sat with the suspect, (B) Michael Anthony, while awaiting investigators to return with a Gun-Shot-Residue kit. We waited for quite a while (approximately an hour) and Anthony talked most of that time. During the entire time my Body Worn Camera (BWC) was running in accord with Department policy. I did not ask Anthony any questions regarding the incident, but he nevertheless described the incident and what led up to the shooting several times and discussed what he was thinking throughout the shooting. Anthony also describes a prior detention/arrest in which his firearms were previously confiscated and discusses his ongoing attempt to obtain a CCW, which he does not yet have.

In general terms, Anthony stated he thought he was in a potentially life-and-death situation because the victim had been aggressive, and Anthony did not know what the victim was going to do next. I will not attempt to transcribe what he said here in this statement, rather, I refer to my video from the incident that starts at 20:55 hours and which runs for approximately 1 hour and 19 minutes. Anthony's comments and description of the shooting are laced throughout the video.

I subsequently uploaded my BWC to Evidence.com. Note, I deactivated and re-activated my BWC several times over the course of the investigation, both to use the facilities and to discuss sensitive law enforcement information regarding the investigation. The section of my BWC in which Anthony discusses the incident, however, is uninterrupted.

We activated our (BWC) Body-Worn Cameras while enroute, which were uploaded and can be retrieved from Evidence. com.

The video and/or audio captured by the BWC is not necessarily all inclusive. The system captures a less broad and detailed image than the totality of the human sense and an officer's account of specific details may appear different than retained audio and/or video.

On April 27, 2023, at approximately 1849 hours, Officer Medina #1525 and I we responded to 825 Market Street (Walgreens) to assist other officers, regarding a shooting. We were in full police uniform and driving a marked police vehicle. Our (BWC1) body worn cameras were activated. The BWC1 was later uploaded to evience.com at Tenderloin Station.

I arrived on scene and started (EVD) crime scene log at approximately 1849 hours and maintained the log until approximately 2316 hours when the crime scene log was broken down.

I collected (EVD) two chest seals that were located on the ground in front of 825 Market Street. I placed the two chest seals into an evidence bag. I kept the crime scene log and the chest seals in my possession until I arrived at Tenderloin Station.

At Tenderloin Station I scanned and uploaded the crime scene log to the report. I handed off the crime scene log and chest seals to Officer Juarez #4140 which he later booked into property at Tenderloin Station.

On 04/27/2023 at approximately 1833 hours, Ofc. Lee #1179 and I were working patrol in the Tenderloin District and responded to 825 Market Street (Walgreens) regarding a shooting.

Upon arrival I observed (V1) Chynna Brown laying on the sidewalk with a gun shot wound to the upper chest. I immediately responded to my SFPD radio car to get the trauma medical kit to attempt life saving measures. As I was grabbing the trauma kit, SFFD Engine #1 responded on scene and began first aid.

Ofc. Lee and I responded to SFGH with AMR medics and Brown.

At SFGH Attending Surgeon Dr. R. Tesoriero and SFGH medic staff treated Brown. Brown was taken to the operating room.

At 2050 hours, Brown was pronounced deceased at SFGH.

Ofc. Lee and I followed the body and SFGH staff from the operating room to the SFGH Morgue. The body was transported to morgue and the room was locked and secured.

My (BWC) Body Worn Camera was activated on scene and the footage was later uploaded to evidence.com.

On 4/27/23 at approximately 1855 hours, Off. Suzuki #1669 and I were in our marked police vehicle, in full police uniform. We responded to Walgreens located at 825 Market Street regarding a shooting.

Off. Suzuki and I activated our (BWC1) Body Worn Camera which was later uploaded on to Evidence.com.

Upon arrival I met with (3J151) Sgt. Lee #398, who directed me to (RW) Donald Washington to retrieve video footage from his cellphone and camera.

I spoke to Washington who attempted to email me the videos but was unable to due to the file size. I used my department issued cellphone to record two videos from his cellphone and one from his camera. The videos showed (V1) Chynna Lashea Brown laying on the ground and an Unknown Male began to check her pulse. The Unknown Male and (B1) Michael Anthony began to remove Lashea Brown's clothes off. Anthony pulls out what appears to be gauze and attempts to provide medical aid to Lashea Brown. The video then shows police officers arriving on scene.

At Tenderloin Station, I placed the videos on a CD and provided it to Off. Juarez #4140.

Sgt. Lee contacted me and advised to return to Walgreens with a GSR kit.

Off. Suzuki and I responded back to Walgreens with a GSR kit.

At Walgreens, I met with Anthony and explained that I was going to perform a (EVD) GSR kit on him. I opened the sealed GSR kit and followed the instructions that was inside of it. I processed Anthony's right and left hand using the sample stub from the GSR kit. I placed the sample stubs inside the plastic bag and sealed it with the red evidence tape from the kit. Anthony placed his right thumb on the ink strip and placed his thumb print on the GSR Data Sheet. I later completed the GSR Data Sheet.

Off. Suzuki and I transported Anthony to the Homicide Office located at 850 Bryant Street.

At the Homicide Office, Homicide investigators conducted their investigation.

Off. Suzuki and I walked Anthony to County Jail #1 where he was booked.

At Tenderloin Station, I booked the GSR Kit into evidence.

On 04/27/2023 at approximately 1834 hours, Officer Avila #820 and I were on patrol in uniform and in a marked patrol vehicle. We were dispatched to (V) Walgreens, located at 825 Market Street, regarding a shooting.

Prior to our arrival, Dispatch advised us that the Walgreens Security Guard had shot a shoplifter.

Upon our arrival, I observed an unknown person, later identified as (V) Chynna Lesheabrown, laying on the ground while other officers were rendering aid.

I approached the security guard, later positively identified as (B) Michael Anthony, who spontaneously stated "here take this" and started to remove his firearm from his drop holster. I advised Anthony to keep all of his equipment and not reach for any of his weapons while we were talking. Anthony spontaneously stated "I didn't want to do that". Anthony showed me a fired cartridge that he had collected prior to our arrival which he was holding in his right hand.

Sqt Shah #2065 arrived on scene and in order to ensure public safety asked Anthony which location the incident happened and in what directions. Anthony said he shot once northbound from Walgreens.

I told Anthony that he was detained and explained to him that I would be removing and seizing his weapons from his person.

With a fresh latex glove, I removed Anthony's primary firearm from his drop leg holster, seized it, and placed it into a fresh paper bag.

I had Anthony place the fired cartridge in a separate bag and seized it.

Anthony said that he had a secondary firearm in a pouch attached to his vest. The pouch was unzipped and open. I reached into the pouch and seized the firearm.

I seized a knife and several magazines from Anthony.

I asked Anthony to remove his vest and other security equipment and seized it.

I transferred control of Anthony to Sgt Connell #433 who escorted Anthony away from other involved parties and remained in control of Anthony until NIU took control.

(E) photographed the firearms and cartridge and remained with all the seized property until CSI Officers Rallis #238 and Simpson #2137 arrived on scene and took control of the items. They also seized the clothing that was removed from Lesheabrown while medics were rendering aid on scene.

I seized Lesheabrown's shopping bag and searched the bag as instructed to do so by NIU Sgt Cuadro #1253. In the bag I located (SR1) 5 candy products and 1 empty Sprite bottle. I returned the items to Walgreens and the cashier provided me with a (E)training receipt. The total for the items was \$14.64. I also located several personal items which included (PFSK) shoes and miscellaneous clothing, a (PFSK) hooded sweatshirt and backpack with hygiene products

and note-taking gear. All personal property was booked at Tenderloin Station as property for safe keeping.

I later viewed the footage retrieved by Officer Barajas #2134. I observed Lesheabrown walking through Walgreens selecting several products from the shelves and placing them into a reusable shopping bag. Lesheabrown passed the manned and opened registers without attempting to pay. Lesheabrown attempted to leave the store but was stopped by Anthony. The two engaged in a fight which resulted in the two fighting on the ground. Several merchandise items fell out of Lesheabrown's bag onto the floor during the fight. After the two separated, Lesheabrown stood up and retrieved her bag. Lesheabrown walked out of the store and turned towards Anthony who appeared to be holding his firearm in his right hand. Lesheabrown made a lunging movement towards Anthony and then quickly backed away as Anthony raised the firearm. Lesheabrown fell to the ground and Anthony paced back and forth. Officer Barajas transferred control of the (E) USB device, which was used to store the footage, to me and I later booked it into evidence at Tenderloin Station. See officer Barajas' statement for further details on the video footage.

While returning to Tenderloin Station, I was notified by Officer Jensen #1423, that Lesheabrown was pronounced deceased by SFGH Physician R. Tesoriero at 2050 Hours. I contacted Officer DeFilippo #2107 at Department Operations Center and notified him of the new circumstances. Officer DeFilippo notified Homicide who later responded to the scene. Officers Jensen and Lee #1179 escorted Lesheabrown with the SFGH staff until secured in the SFGH morgue. Officer Cato #250 responded to SFGH and remained until the SF Medical Examiner Hoogasian #121 provided him with a (E) ME Property Receipt. Officer Cato seized the ME Property Receipt, and I later took control of the ME Property Receipt and booked it into evidence at Tenderloin Station.

Per NIU and Homicide, Officer Jimenez #2580 was instructed to seize (E) medical chest seals left on scene. I later took control of the chest seals and booked them into evidence at Tenderloin Station. Officer Jimenez was instructed to break down the crime scene and closed the (E) Crime Scene log. I later took control of the Crime Scene log and booked it into Evidence at Tenderloin Station.

I printed the (E) photos taken by Officer Avila and booked them into evidence at Tenderloin Station. I uploaded the photos to this report excluding photos of Lesheabrown as they showed sensitive areas of their body and they were later pronounced deceased.

Officer Katsumoto #2429 told me that he had obtained video footage from (RW) Washington and placed it onto a (E) CD. I took control of the CD and later booked it into evidence at Tenderloin Station.

I had my (BWC) body worn camera activated during the investigation and later uploaded the footage to evidence.com. It should be noted that I deactivated my camera when I left the scene but reactivated when requested to return by NIU for further investigation.
