I'm 17 going to let you go, but I'm gonna need you to calm down." And so, um I repeated it to her... once I let go. I stood back because the whole time we were wrestling she's saying she's gonna stab me and that's 18 what really put the fear in my heart. Um, and then I'll have the...uh, what do you call that...the plate carrier. I had the plate carrier on top of that and um.... Yeah. I normally have that on...um. And it says "Security" on it um, on...on the vest itself it has the patch of the KGB.

HI-1: Vest. So you're identified as a security.

MA: Yes, um...identified.

HI-1: Do you carry any other equipment on the plate carrier?

HI-1: Yes; I don't use it for a weapon, but I have a knife on there...in case I was like in a situation, for utility purposes.

MA: I carry medical supplies and I had a backup firearm, as well... in my pouch.
