INSURANCE AND ROADSIDE ASSISTANT SERVICE

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Ask the assistance dispatcher which tow company they are sending.
- Ask the tow truck driver who dispatched them (which insurance company or roadside assistance service).
- Verify with the driver, they have a valid motor carrier permit (SF requires this).
- Be sure to ask where your car is being taken. This will avoid unnecessary delays in retrieving the vehicle and additional storage charges!
- Do not let your car be towed if you have any doubts about the roadside assistance service.

IF YOU CALLED A TOW TRUCK

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- If done through police dispatcher, ask for a tow verification number.
- Ask the tow truck driver for the Police Tow Number.
- Take picture of tow truck name & phone number.
- Verify with the driver, they have a valid motor carrier permit (SF requires this) and the company is licensed to tow in SF (tow company permitted).
- Be sure to ask where your car is being taken. This will avoid unnecessary delays in retrieving the vehicle and additional storage charges!
- Do not let your car be towed if you have any doubts about the roadside assistance service.
