Specifically, what are examples of the field response piece that is required for this project?</p>	<p>The 24/7 response is one of several modalities that a proposer may offer in their proposal. It can entail any of the following support services after hours:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crisis intervention and emotional stabilization • Safety planning • Explaining next steps with law enforcement/investigation • Connecting victims and survivors with emergency resources • Emergency housing/shelter/hotel coordination • Connection to clothing/food/basic needs • Warm handoffs to appropriate providers
