The Notice of Protest must be signed by an individual authorized to represent the proposer, and must cite the law, rule, local ordinance, procedure, or RFP provision on which the protest is based. In addition, the Notice of Protest must specify facts and evidence sufficient for the City to determine the validity of the protest.
